



CITY TO SEA GREENWAY

City to Sea Greenway Project

The City to Sea Greenway is a shared use path (pedestrians and cyclists) that extends from the Subiaco Redevelopment Area westwards to the coast at City Beach. The \$360,000 Project is an initiative of the Better Cities Project and Bikewest and is jointly funded by these two agencies together with the Town of Cambridge, through which the City to Sea Greenway runs.

The path is a 3.0 metre wide asphalt dual use path, constructed in three distinct sections, and designed to capitalise on an existing path which occurs in the locality.

The tasks involved in completing this project included :

- examining alternative alignments, evaluating options, selecting the preferred alignment,
- community consultation and liaison with a range of government and non-government authorities, private organisations, individuals and community groups,
- preparation and presentation of reports to the Council of the Town of Cambridge,
- preparation of preliminary cost estimates, preparation of tender documentation,
- selection of tenderers, and project management of the construction of the path.
